You will need:

Yarn: Schachenmayr Baby Smiles Bravo Baby 185

Hook: 3.5mm

You can choose a completely different yarn than suggested. In this case, you need to choose the

size of the hook yourself. For help, read the yarn label.


Stitch marker

Abbreviations:

ch= chain;
sc= single crochet;
dc= double crochet;
dc2tog= double crochet 2 together;
dc 3 tog = double crochet 3 together

Written Instructions:

You have to make multiple of 23 chain + 3 chain.

Row 1: Ch 4, make 9 dc (starting with the 7th ch from the hook) 2ch, skip 2 ch, 3 dc in the same ch, 2ch, skip 2 ch, dc 2 tog, 3 dc, dc 2 tog, 2 ch; *skip 2ch, 9dc, 2ch, skip 2 ch, 3 dc in the same ch, 2ch, skip 2 ch, dc 2 tog, 3 dc, dc 2 tog, 2 ch* repeat *-*; 1 dc in the last ch.

Row 2: Ch4, *dc 2 tog, 1 dc, dc 2 tog, 2 ch, 2 dc in 1st dc of the *3dc of the previous row*, 1dc, 2dc in the 3rd dc of the *3dc of the previous row*, 2 ch, dc 2 tog, 5dc, dc 2tog, 2 ch*, repeat *-*, 1dc in the *4ch-space* of previous row.

Row 3: Ch 4, *dc 2 tog, 3 dc, dc 2 tog, 2 ch, 3 dc in the 2ch-space of previous row, 2 ch, 2 dc in the same dc, 3 dc, 2 dc in the same dc, 2 ch, dc 3 tog, 2 ch* repeat *-*, 1 dc in the 4ch-space of previous row.

Row 4: Ch 4, *2 dc in the same dc, 5 dc, 2 dc in the same dc, 2 ch, 2 dc in the same dc, 1 dc, 2 dc in the same dc, 2 ch, dc 2 tog, 1 dc, dc 2 tog, 2 ch*, repeat *-*, 1 dc in the 4ch-space of previous row.

Row 5: Ch 4, *dc 3 tog, 2 ch, 2 dc in the same dc, 3 dc, 2 dc in the same dc, 2 ch, 9 dc, 2 ch*, repeat *-*, 1 dc *in the 4ch-space* of previous row.

Row 6: Ch 4, * dc 2 tog, 5 dc, dc 2 tog, 2 ch, 2 dc in the same dc, 5 dc, 2 dc in the same dc, 2 ch*, repeat *-*, 1 dc *in the 4ch-space* of previous row.

Row 7: Ch 4, * 9 dc, 2 ch, 3 dc in the space of 2 ch of previous row, 2 ch, dc 2 tog, 3 dc, dc 2 tog, 2ch*, repeat *-*, 1 dc *in the 4ch-space* of previous row.

Repeat Row 2 to Row 7 until you reach the desired length.

Make an edge, if you want: working 2 rounds of sc's.

You can wash it by hand or in a washing machine at 30 degrees, or depending on the yarn you use. (Read carefully the label!) Blocking or ironing it, if needed.
